REGISTRATION PROCESS

Procedure for registration of construction workers

- Men or women working as building and other construction workers are entitled for registration BOCW Workers
- Age Limit for Registration as BOCW Worker Is between 18 to 60 years
- Necessary to submit a copy of documents as proofs like Proof of age, Voter ID card, Ration card, Adhar Card, 3 passport size photographs, bank passbook
- Self-attested certificate for working as a construction worker minimum 90 days
